Kinrix- DTaP/IPV (Given at 4yrs.)
 Pediarix - DTaP/IPV/Hep B (Given at 2, 4, 6 mths)
 Pentacel- DTaP/IPV/HIB
 Proquad- MMR/Varivax (Given at 4yrs.)

These vaccines protect against the following diseases:

Gardasil/HPV- (Recommended, but not required)--Human Papilloma Virus, which causes cervical cancer.
 DTaP/Tdap- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (whooping cough)
 HIB- Heamophilus Influenza type B meningitis
 IPV - Polio
 MCV-4-Meningococcal Meningitis
 MMR-Measles, Mumps, Rubella
 PCV-13- Pneumococcal Pneumonia
 Rotarix/Rotateq-Virus causing severe diarrhea and vomiting
 Varivax-Chicken Pox
